Information and Availability List

Naloxone or Narcan are commonly used names of naloxone hydrochloride. It is an opioid blocker that reverses the effects of opioids including respiratory depression, which is the most common cause of overdose death. It can effectively reverse an overdose for about 30-90 minutes, which means it is still important to call 9-1-1. It is generally administered through injection to the muscle by medical professionals, but can also be administered through the use of an intranasal atomizer (nose spray).

Narcan works on opioids only, including prescriptions like Fentanyl and OxyContin, as well as heroin. Ohio HB 170 allows distribution to users at high risk of overdose, as well as their friends and family members. The law also allows administration without liability.

Narcan is available from the following location in Tuscarawas and Carroll Counties. It is recommended that you call ahead to check availability and to ask about any additional requirements for distribution.
